SROC is prepared to allow **M/W16s** to compete on the Elite courses, **subject to parental consent**. (Note: any M/W14 or younger must enter the Junior course which stays within Astley Park and so does not require parental consent.)

SROC Officials are happy to discuss individual concerns over safety issues, but the final responsibility for giving consent lies with Parents & Legal Guardians.
