Location: Dalton Craggs, a stretch of 119 hectares (294 acres) of land east of Burton-in-Kendal, is a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) with limestone pavements and native woodland. (Grid ref SD552761).
Parking (£1.00 per vehicle)

Registration: 11.30 until 13.45
Starts: 12.00 until 14.00
Fees: £2.00 Adults (no BOF discount)
£1.00 juniors

SI electronic punching will be used. SI cards are available for loan, Loss will incur a charge of £20.00.

Courses available: This is a score event, with a choice of two courses. One uses control sites of a more technical nature than the other. Both have a time limit of 1 hour. Score 10 points for each correct control visited, penalty of 10 points for every 3 minutes (or part thereof) late back. Bring a watch!

Start & Finish: 100m from the car park. Follow tapes

Safety: All competitors take part at their own risk. There are several large crags, all clearly marked on the map. These have been avoided when planning the courses. Take care if wet as the many limestone crags, boulders and pavement become very slippery.
Please dress according to the weather conditions.

Toilets: There will be no toilets at the event.

The event will only be cancelled if weather conditions are severe.
