



Torver High Common SROC District Event Sunday 2 November 2008

An Yvette Baker Preliminary Round.

Venue/Terrain: The area is on the high ground west of Torver village. This is high open moor on Lake District Technical terrain. There are plenty of opportunities to get lost especially in bad weather so come prepared. Whistles compulsory. Cagoules are also likely to be needed and may be compulsory on the day.

Access is at Grid Ref 263 934. Parking is in Broughton Forest Slate Quarry. Vehicles and pedestrians should keep to roadways in the quarry as the sides may be unstable.

Directions from South: Leave A590 at Greenodd onto A5092. After 3km turn right onto A5084 for Torver/Coniston. In Torver village turn left onto A593. After 1km turn right on steep minor road (will be signed). After further 1 km on narrow road turn right into Broughton Slate Quarry. Take care on the quarry road as competitors will be walking along it to and from the start and finish.

Directions from North: Go through Coniston to Torver and follow above instructions from Torver. Do not attempt to approach northbound on the A593 from Broughton in Furness as turning onto the minor road from this direction is dangerous.

Map: 1:10,000 A3 Peel Land Surveys. **Rough Open is printed with a lighter-than-standard yellow for easier reading of contour detail.** Please note there will be **no White or Red Course** due to lack of suitable terrain. ** The Yellow course will have its own start and finish in less technical terrain, but competitors on the Yellow course need to be able to follow walls, fences and streams (not just tracks) and expect to get wet feet!

Start and Finish – There will be 2 starts. The main start (all courses except Yellow) is about 500m over rough ground from parking. Allow 20min. The Yellow course start is approx 800m back (south) along the quarry road from parking. Allow 20min. The main finish is about 1km (south) along the quarry road from parking. The Yellow course finish is a short distance from parking.

Sport Ident punching used - Can be hired at registration. If lost cost of £22 will be payable.
