



**South Ribble Orienteering Club**  
**Saturday, 17th December 2011**  
**Night Event at Worden Park, Leyland.**  
**(Event 2 of the North West Night League)**

- Car Park:** Worden Lane, PR25 3DW. Grid Ref: SD543207
- Travel:** Signed from junction of Worden Lane and Langdale Road at the above grid reference. If approaching along Langdale Road, which is the best route from M6 junction 28, the entrance to the park is directly opposite the junction with Worden Lane. There are small no entry signs to unauthorized vehicles on the gateway, these do not apply to those attending the orienteering. Drive slowly ~300m to turn right at sign 100m in to car park.
- Map/Terrain:** Updated map 2011, scale 1: 5000, 5m contours. Mixture of open parkland, landscaped gardens and woodland. Included on the map for the first time, as an inset at a scale of 1:1000, is the 150 year old maze. While the original maze was planted with hornbeam hedging, this has been reinforced with high metal fencing and should not be crossed.
- A stream runs along the southern edge of the map, which in normal conditions is up to knee deep. It should not be crossed if in spate. There are numerous bridges marked using the bridge symbol in red which can easily be used when necessary.
- A map will be on display at registration and start.
- Courses:**
- Orange 2.7 km, 20m climb, 15 controls
  - Green 3.8 km, 30m climb, 18 controls
  - Blue 5.4 km, 60m climb, 25 controls, uses a two part map Start to 8 on one side, 9 to finish on the other. Each is clearly marked, take care to start on Part 1.
- All courses enter the maze and require the control at the entrance to be punched on entry and on exit. Loose control descriptions for all courses will be available at registration. All courses are printed on A4 waterproof paper.
- For day time orienteering in this park the SI units have to be cabled to ensure their security. Although less people are expected in the park at night, it has been decided to use secure the SI units using cables that pass through the hole in the unit, this can impede the ease of dishing.
- Registration:** Registration in the car park from 5:30 to 7:00.
- Start/Finish:** From 6:00 to 7:15 PM. Both are situated on the edge of the car park.
- Courses Close:** 8:30PM.
- Fees:** Seniors £6, Juniors & Students £3 (plus £2 for senior non BOF members)
- SI-punching:** SI-card hire £1 seniors, free for juniors, but £30 if lost.
- Facilities:** Toilets in the park will be locked, nearest toilets in Tesco Extra in Leyland, just follow Worden Lane north to town centre ~500m.
- Safety:** Whistles should be carried. Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. Following a recent wet spell of weather the area is both muddy and slippery. It is suggested that the stream is crossed using the bridges, this should be the only means of crossing used if the stream is in spate.
