Location: Eaves Wood, Silverdale GR SD471761. Parking in Girl Guide field adjoining National Trust Car Park. Parking fee £1

Start times 12.30-1.30.

Courses: beginners/improvers 2.7Km (orange) and hard 4.4Km (green).

Fees: £5 per adult or family in one group.

£2 per junior

Start and finish in field adjacent to parking.

Terrain: Delightful mixed woodland with a good path network. Please take care on the limestone which can be very slippery, especially so when wet.

There are “conservation” cattle grazing on parts of the area. They will not bother you, but please respect them by giving them space.

The area is well used by the public, some of whom will have dogs with them. Please respect both!

All walls and fences are to be crossed only at proper crossing point. No walls or fences to be climbed.

**Note: There are no toilets at the event. Please use the public toilets in the centre of Silverdale village.**
